Position Overview:

The Associate Teacher will work within an interdisciplinary team that includes an Intervention Specialist, Speech Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Behavior Specialists, Art Therapists, Music Therapist, Recreational Therapist, Horticulture Therapist, and additional Associate Teachers. Classroom teams are intentionally small, so students can receive one-on-one and small group instruction, within the confines of Monarch's visual language immersion teaching Model. The Model combines concept-driven language instruction with visual supports, technology and Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA).

This is a great position for those looking to gain experience in careers such as special education, occupational therapy, speech therapy, behavior analysis, and more!

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Assisting in the teaching and behavior management of the classroom
- Helping to develop and implement lesson plans and curriculum that align with IEP and/or ISP goals and objectives
- Helping to develop instructional materials including visual supports
- Helping to plan and organize daily activities to optimize treatment
- Taking data and contributing to clinical records and documentation
- Caring for students in a variety of settings and capacities
- Collaborating with interdisciplinary team members
