### **Position Overview:**

The Speech Language Pathologist (SLP) will work within an interdisciplinary team that includes Intervention Specialists, Associate Teachers, Occupational Therapists, Behavior Specialists, Art Therapists, Music Therapist, Recreational Therapist, Horticulture Therapist, and additional SLPs. Through our collaboration with Dr. Howard Shane at Boston Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School, we offer many opportunities for professional growth. Small caseload sizes (approximately 10 students), a cohesive SLP Department (with more than 20 on-site SLPs), and access to an abundant supply of technology, equipment and assessments, provide an exceptional work environment. We offer on-site clinical supervision of CFYs, a competitive salary, and excellent benefits.

### **Responsibilities include but are not limited to:**

- Providing direct speech therapy to students in one-on-one and small group settings
- Developing and running social pragmatic groups for students
- Administering and evaluating diagnostic assessments
- Writing speech/language progress reports and other clinical records and documentation
- Writing, implementing and measuring speech-related IEP goals and objectives
- Collaborating with interdisciplinary team members

- Valid Ohio Speech/Language Pathologist license or Conditional Speech Language Pathologist license (CF) required.
- Combination of education, training and/or experience working with children with autism.
- Issued 5-year professional license from the Ohio Department of Education.
